Priority Need:

There is a high priority need for someone to oversee recess and lunchtime. A great opportunity to see your child & their friends during the day, too! Parent volunteer needed weekly:

Tuesday and/or Thursday from 11:00 – 11:45, and 12:00-12:45.

Ideally, this role is needed for the school year. However there can be flexibility/creativity in how this is done (ie: multiple parents on a team that would work to split up days). Interested parents should inquire to discuss options.

Need 2 dads (or a father/son team) to finish laying landscape fabric (provided) to the front yard of the school. Bring a rake & gloves. Estimated time needed 2 hours. Can be done at any time of day/weekend.

Do you have a truck or trailer? NLCS is looking for someone who can load up the broken freezer from the kitchen to the landfill. Dump fee will be reimbursed. Can be done at any time of day/weekend. Estimated time needed 1 hour. For access off hours, contact Deanna Dymarkowski.

Need 1 volunteer to do some pruning of small bushes at the entrance to the parking lot. Estimated time needed 30 minutes. Can be done at any time of day/weekend.

Need 1-2 people (parent/student will work) in charge of sweeping playground rocks and front entrance. Estimated time needed 45 minutes, once or twice per week. Bring large broom(s) or a blower.

The bulletin board in the entry way needs to be completed. We have all the supplies, just need a volunteer to put them up.

As you are volunteering here, please be sure and record your hours in the log book so that you will get credit for them. Uncompleted hours will be billed at \$25/hour.
