

RE-ENROLLMENT FORMS:

Re-Enrollment forms have already gone home. It is very important that you fill them out and return them to the office ASAP, as this document is used to plan enrollment, budgets, and curriculum for the upcoming school year. Please note the dates and enrollment fees: To insure your spot for next year, we are requiring a \$125 continuing enrollment fee per student. This fee is non-refundable and must be paid by May 24th. After May 24th the fee increases to \$200 per student.

This applies to our entire student body, from Preschool-8th grade.

DO YOU KNOW ABOUT OUR KINDERGARTEN INCENTIVE PROGRAM?

The total amount of money that was paid to NLCS for preschool enrollment in the Preschool and KinderPrep classes will be used as credit towards your child's tuition during their Kindergarten year at NLCS. The credit will be divided in 12 equal amounts and applied equally to each month's tuition of the payment plan while your child is enrolled and attending NLCS. This credit will begin after the application and enrollment process is completed and your child has been accepted into the NLCS Kindergarten program.

TALENT SHOW

Auditions for the Talent Show will be held on Thursday May 23rd from 9:30 to 10:30. Please have any props and/or music that will be part of your act so that we can make sure they are appropriate. The Talent Show will be held May 31st.
