## **RE-ENROLLMENT FORMS:**

Re-Enrollment forms have already gone home. It is very important that you fill them out and return them to the office ASAP, as this document is used to plan enrollment, budgets, and curriculum for the upcoming school year. Please note the dates and enrollment fees: To insure your spot for next year, we are requiring a \$125 continuing enrollment fee per student. This fee is non-refundable and must be paid by May 24th. After May 24th the fee increases to \$200 per student. This applies to our entire student body, from Preschool-8th grade.

## **DO YOU KNOW ABOUT OUR KINDERGARTEN INCENTIVE PROGRAM?**

The total amount of money that was paid to NLCS for preschool enrollment in the Preschool and KinderPrep classes will be used as credit towards your child's tuition during their Kindergarten year at NLCS. The credit will be divided in 12 equal amounts and applied equally to each month's tuition of the payment plan while your child is enrolled and attending NLCS. This credit will begin after the application and enrollment process is completed and your child has been accepted into the NLCS Kindergarten program.

## **WIN-WIN PROGRAM:**

The best way to attract students to our school is to share your child(ren)'s experience with your neighbors, friends, and members of your church! New Life wants to incentivize you to recruit new students with the Win-Win Program. When you share, and new families enroll their children (Kindergarten - 8th Grade) at New Life, we are offering both your family and the new family a one-month tuition credit (up to \$517 value for each family). Students must be accepted and enrolled by August 26, 2019. There's a Win-Win Program Flyer in your folder with additional information, as well as the 2019-2020 Tuition Schedule.

## **VARIABLE TUITION**

We understand a Christian education can be a financial burden for your family, but the rewards for your sacrifice are great! It is our hope and desire that all families who are committed to an academically rigorous, Christ-centered education can join us at New Life Christian School. To achieve that goal, New Life Christian School provides variable tuition based on your family's ability to pay. If your family can benefit from variable tuition, please complete a variable tuition application. Additionally, New Life Christian School provides an interest-free 12-month payment plan. We are unable to provide variable tuition for Preschool and KinderPrep students.

To determine variable tuition rates, the Board of New Life Christian School is utilizing FAST to assess these requests. The application should take approximately 45 minutes to complete and does not need to be completed in a single session. Applications may be completed from June 3rd through July 12th. Award decisions will be made on August 1st.
