

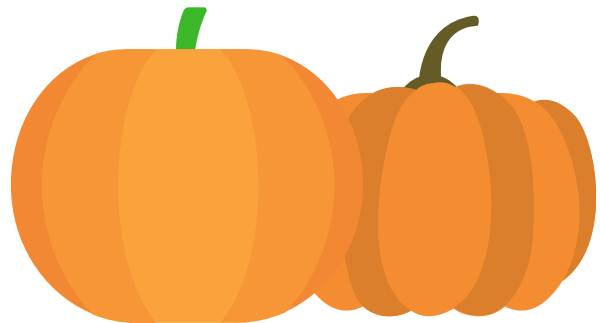

## IN CASE YOU DIDN'T KNOW...

Here's some clarification to some of the days on the calendar:

- **Failure Day:** This is the halfway point between Progress Reports and Report Cards. If your child has an 'F' in any class, their teacher will be contacting you to let you know. This should allow for plenty of time to remedy the situation by the time Report Cards come out.
- **See You at the Pole:** Is a prayer rally where students meet at the school flagpole to lift up their school, teachers and nation to God.
- **PT Conf:** Stands for Parent Teacher Conferences. Parent Teacher Conferences are scheduled in the fall, and again in the spring.
- **Speech Meet:** Gives the students opportunity to practice public speaking. Students will memorize and recite poems, Bible verses, etc. and present them to their classmates, teachers, and judges. The classroom Speech Meet is judged, and the top students from each classroom will move on to the school wide Speech Meet, where they will present their pieces in front of the entire school.
- **Field Day:** Is a day where local Christian schools come together to compete in fun outdoor activities such as three-legged races, softball toss, frisbee throw, relay races, etc. This takes place in Wenatchee.
- **Spirit Week:** Spirit week is an opportunity for the students and the staff to enjoy a shared experience centered on generating excitement for our school. Daily themes are chosen and everyone is encouraged to dress up and participate in this fun time.
