BIKE RODEO - April 23rd

The Kindergarten - 6th grade students will be participating in a bicycle safety program presented by the Ephrata Police Department on Wednesday, April 23rd.

During the bike rodeo, students will be given the opportunity to test their skills in a variety of ways. We encourage all students to wear a bike helmet during the bike rodeo and any time they are riding their bicycles. Each bike will undergo a safety inspection. Students who participate will receive a written record of their performance, a copy of the safety inspection and registration, and a certificate of participation.

Students will need to have their own bikes to ride during the rodeo. All bikes need to be dropped off before school begins and picked up at 3:00 p.m.

All bikes must be in good working order for the biking season (air in tires, functioning brakes, reflectors, etc.). No training wheels, please.
