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Spring Art Fair 2025 Rules, Categories, & Age Groups

<u>4 Categories</u>

- Watercolor
- Photography
- Pencil {see rules for each category
- Mixed Media

Crayon, pencil, colored pencil, marker, oil pastel

Age Groups

Kinder5-71-28-123-4

Guidelines

- May sign up for one category only.
- Work will be done on your own time.
- Please follow rules for each category.
- Entries must be finished and turned into the art room during the week of May 19-21 by end of school day, or entry will not be accepted.
- Must be done within the 24/25 school year.
- YOU MUST INCLUDE the Category, Name, and Grade on a post it note and attach it to the entry.
- All entries should be turned into either homeroom teacher or to art teacher.

Watercolor/Paint:

Clear subject, neat work, the use of paints, watercolors or watercolor crayons (must be finished with water), 8.5x11 watercolor paper, title of work with name and grade of student attached.

Photography:

Clear and focused subject, 5x7 photo, can be color or black and white, title of work with name and grade of student attached.

Pencil/Line art:

Clean and clear subject must be freehand, use of pencil only, may have one color only (also in pencil), 8.5x11paper, title of work with name and grade of student attached.

Mixed Media:

Clear and neat subject, may have all or at minimum three of the following medias included in project, 8.5x11paper, title of work with name and grade of student attached.

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How your work will be judged:

A) Neatness/Effort

Appropriately finished, good use of technique, clean and neat effort

B) Content (following guidelines for the style of project)

Design related to intended use, balance, harmony at first impression, fulfilled intent

C) Interpretation

Clarity of the theme to the viewer (does the project look like what the category states)

There will be first, second, and third place prizes in each age group and an overall Grand Prize winner out of all entries.

There will be a sign-up sheet in the Art room. Please add your name if you will be entering the contest.
