I just wanted to let you know that the library won't be open to check out books this summer. I am so sorry to do this, but due to the portable needing repairs and continuing the project of putting our books into Sycamore, this summer will focus on getting our library collection ready for you in the fall. I will miss seeing you all this summer! If you would like any book recommendations I would be SO happy to send you some! My email is bgregg@nlcs.us.

I also wanted to encourage you to get a library card with our NCW Library system. It is completely free and such a special thing to have as a child (or any age!). If you remember The Library Card song from the PBS show Arthur, they sing: "having fun isn't hard when you've got a library card!" It's very true!

Though sometimes I have been disappointed by the selection at our public library, I was recently reminded and encouraged that the library is still a wonderful resource and has many options for getting books that are true, good, and beautiful. There's a couple ways you can go about this (aside from just exploring the shelves on your own, which is still a fun option!)

- Once you get a library card, you can login to NCW libraries online. From there, you can search specific books, place holds, and if it is not available in our library system, they will get it to you through InterLibrary Loan. This is where they put in a request to a different library system and the book is mailed to your preferred pickup library. And if you check out a book from another library within NCW, I believe they will also bring it to your preferred pick up library.
- If you have a kindle or tablet you like to read on, download the Libby app on your phone. From there, you can login with your NCW library info and you will have access to their completely free E-book selection. I have found some wonderful books there, as well as many that I had wanted to read for awhile. You can put filters as you search for books, and when you find one you want to read, you check it out and send it to your kindle (or other device). While I still very much prefer and recommend reading out of an actual book, the kindle has been a nice way to quickly get books and read them easily.
- When I find new books for myself or for my daughter, I always look them up on Book Reviews Archives - Redeemed Reader to see if they have been reviewed by the wonderful team at Redeemed Reader. They give honest, thoughtful reviews from a Christian perspective, and discuss any content concerns and their recommended age for each book (which is often different from what the publishers recommend). They also have a great resource page of book lists: Book Lists - Redeemed Reader. I would also be more than happy to answer any questions about particular books or series if I am able to! Please feel free to send me a text message (503-348-2049) with the title or picture of the book, and I will do my best to let you know any information about it that I can find!

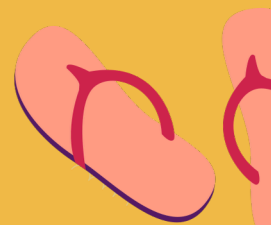
