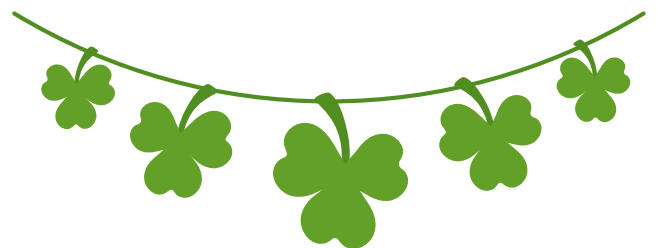
## What is meant by *plundering the Egyptians*?
